- **5K (3.1 miles) run/walk @ 8:30AM (\$20 to register at Handyman/Ace or on-line at www.keysports.net- you receive a T-shirt and water bottle if registered prior to July 30)**
- **Kids ¼ mile fun run @ 8:15AM (FREE –no T-shirt or water bottle)**

The 5K will start at the Broadmoor & Broadview intersection, proceed South on Broadmoor, on Greenmount, enter the new bike path to a turn-around point on that path, returning to the starting point via same route.

We need participants: You, your friends, kids, grandkids, anyone you know. If you're not familiar with this type event (5K= 3.1 miles). Participants can run or walk the route. It's ALL for fun & health and to create a monetary donations for the "Children's Miracle Network".
