## By-Law Revision Proposal

### Article VII: TRUSTEES/TERM OF OFFICE/VACANCIES/MEETINGS

The Board of Trustees shall be composed of a minimum of nine (9) and not more than fifteen (15) members of the Patterson Park Civic Association. The trustees must be residents of Patterson Park who are 18 years of age or older. The term of office for a Trustee shall be three years, renewable annually.

- Propose to change "fifteen (15)" to "eighteen (18)"
- Propose to add a clause that allows up to two non-residential Patterson Park Business owners to run for Trustee positions.

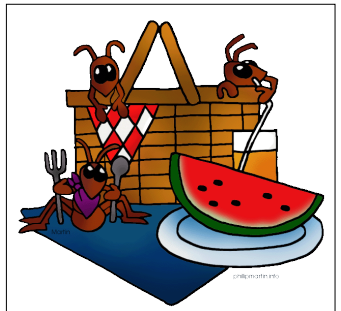

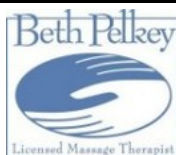
