Leaf Pick Up



It's that time of year when the leaves begin to fall. Patterson Park leaf pickups are scheduled for October 26, November 9 and 23, and December 7. Leaves must be in biodegradable paper bags and placed at the curb. You may also drop off leaves at the Belmont Maintenance Building located on Highridge Avenue behind Lohrey Recreation Center from October 27 through December 12. The hours are: Monday-Friday, 8 am— 6 pm; Saturday, Noon—5 pm; and Sunday, 1 pm— 5 pm. You may also drop leaves off at the Montgomery County Yard Waste location on Encrete Lane in Moraine. Hours are Monday—Friday 8 am—6 pm and Saturday from 8 am—3 pm.

Leaves raked to the curb will not be collected. *(Those violating the bag program by raking leaves to the curb may be assessed a \$75 charge.)* Loose leaves can clog catch basins and cause street flooding. If you have a sewer catch basin near your property, please clear away leaves or other debris on a regular basis.
